Hamlet Act 2 Scene 2 Allusion in First Player's Monologue

- Prince Hamlet, seeking revenge (hesitantly)
- King Hamlet, father slain by Claudius
- Gertrude, wife of King Hamlet who marries
 Claudius rather than mourn

- Pyrrhus, seeking revenge (brutally)
- Achilles, father slain by Priam
- Hecuba, wife of Priam who mourns for the rest of her life (symbol for intense grief)
