Exception:

Neither Casper nor the other ghosts need to visit a tanning salon.
Either a robin or vicious squirrels pelt acorns at unsuspecting joggers on the path.

Plural Pronouns

both

few

many

several

Singular or Plural Pronouns

depending on reference word

all

any

most

none

some

Examples:

Most of the underwear is covered with hearts and happy faces.

Most of the Jockey shorts are pressed and starched.

Neither my mother nor my father get it, though.

I'll be fourteen in February, and every one of my friends, along with, I think, maybe one of my teachers, say I'm very mature and intelligent for my age.
