## **Assessment 1: Etymology Presentation**

Working collaboratively in assigned groups, students engage research the etymology of English vocabulary using multiple online and print sources to determine the history of a group of words. The group must incorporate digital media into the effective presentation of its research findings to the class.

Presentation must reveal research and understanding about the following questions

- From which period of English do the words derive?
- What are the language(s) of origin or kinship?
- How have the meanings of the words changed over time?
- What cultural/historical influences on the development of words can be inferred?
- In what ways are these words related?
- How do the words reflect the people, the times, and the cultural changes in which they lived?
- How are migration, mixture, and transformation evident in these words?
