Heart of Darkness chapter 1

- pages 16-18 ("Next day I left that station at last" to "that, and the repairs when I brought the pieces to the station, took some months."
- <u>pages 19-21</u> ("He began to speak as soon as he saw me." <u>to</u> "But there is a way of looking at a halter that would provoke the most charitable of saints into a kick."
- <u>pages 21-22</u> ("I had no idea why he wanted to be sociable" <u>to</u>
 "When Mr. Kurtz,' I continued, severely, 'is General Manager, you won't have the opportunity.")
- pages 23-24 ("I let him run on" to "in the heavy night air of the river."
- <u>pages 25-27</u> ("He was becoming confidential now" <u>to</u> ""he would set about his work when there.")
