1. For each question you missed, identify the context clues within the sentence(s) that support the correct answer(s). Explain the connection between the context clues and the correct answer(s)—synonym, antonym, degree, example, contrast, etc.
2. In your own words, provide the contextually accurate meaning for each part of the correct answer as well as for the incorrect choice you selected.
3. Compose sentences for each word in the correct answer and your incorrect answer. Your sentences must be about a text we have read and must contain precise contextual detail to illustrate meaning.
